O R D E R

On February 4, 2004, Oldham County Water District ("Oldham County") applied for authority to revise certain non-recurring charges. Oldham County has provided adequate evidence of the individual expenses incurred to provide the services associated with the proposed charges.

1. The proposed charges are equal to the expenses incurred to provide the associated services.
2. The charges and policies set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges in the Appendix are approved for services rendered on and after March 18, 2005.
2. The revised tariff sheets Oldham County filed setting out the proposed rates are approved as filed.
