On March 31, 2005, the Attorney General, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention, requested full intervention in this case and also requested a brief extension in the procedural schedule. The Commission, finding that both requests should be granted, HEREBY ORDERS that:

2. The Attorney General shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
3. Should the Attorney General file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, he shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.

4. The procedural schedule attached to the Commission's March 23, 2005 Order as Appendix A is revised as set forth in Appendix A attached hereto.
