## ORDER

On June 17, 2005, Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") filed an application for approval of the construction of a transmission line in Leslie County, Kentucky. Pursuant to KRS 278.020(8), the Commission must issue a final decision on the application no later than 90 days after it is filed, unless good cause exists to extend this time period to 120 days.

The Commission has employed a consulting firm to prepare and file in the record of this case a report on Kentucky Power's need for the proposed transmission line. That report is not scheduled to be filed until approximately 30 days after the application was filed. To provide the applicant and any intervenors adequate time to review the consultant's report, the Commission finds good cause to extend the statutory review time from 90 days to 120 days. the Commission further finds that the procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A to this Order should be followed in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the statutory time period in which a final decision must be issued in this case is extended to 120 days and the procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A shall be followed.
