O R D E R

On April 1, 2005, U.S. 60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties (“U.S. 60 Water”) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. U.S. 60 Water purchases water from the city of Frankfort (“Frankfort”).
2. On February 18, 2005, Frankfort filed notice with the Commission of a proposed revision to its current wholesale water rate for U.S. 60 Water. Under this revision, Frankfort would increase its wholesale water service rate, effective March 21, 2005, from \$1.418 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.539 per 1,000 gallons.
3. Pursuant to KRS 278.180 and 278.190, Frankfort’s proposed rate revision became effective on March 21, 2005.
4. During the 12 months ending December 2004, U.S. 60 Water purchased 175,445,205 gallons from Frankfort and sold 128,011,600. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$21,229, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons.

5. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. U.S. 60 Water's proposed rates are approved.

2. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved for water service rendered on and after May 1, 2005.

3. The proposed tariff sheets filed by U.S. 60 Water are accepted as filed.
