O R D E R

On April 4, 2005, Rick Melton, on behalf of Rick's Auto Body ("Complainant"), filed a complaint against Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") requesting that the Commission enter an Order forbidding KU from collecting an additional \$500 deposit. On April 14, 2005, the Commission entered an Order directing KU, within 10 days of the date of the Order, to answer or to satisfy the matters complained of in the complaint.¹ On April 25, 2005, KU filed its answer with the Commission. In its answer KU claims to have satisfied the complaint and states that it has removed the additional deposit from Complainant's account.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(5), after an offer of satisfaction by a Defendant, a Complainant's acceptance of the offer, and the Commission's approval, no further proceedings are necessary. It appears from the record that KU has offered to

satisfy all of the matters of which Complainant complained. As of the date of this Order, the Commission has received nothing from the Complainant that indicates whether it accepts or rejects KU's offer of satisfaction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, Complainant shall file with the Commission notice of its acceptance or rejection of KU's offer of satisfaction.

2. If no such filing is received, the complaint shall be considered satisfied, and this case shall be closed.
