<u>ORDER</u>

On July 11, 2005, the Concerned Citizens Against the Power Line Extension ("Citizens") filed a motion for an extension of time to prefile its testimony in this case. Pursuant to the previously ordered procedural schedule, the testimony would be due on July 15, 2005; Citizens requests that it be allowed to file that testimony on July 19, 2005.

As reason for the request, Citizens states that, as of the date of filing the motion, it had not received the Applicants' responses to data requests that were due on July 7, 2005. Thus, neither Citizens nor its experts had been able to review those responses in order to prepare the testimony. No party filed a response to Citizens's motion.

In light of the allegations in the motion and the absence of any opposition, the Commission finds that the requested extension should be granted. Citizens may file its testimony in this case on July 19, 2005.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Citizens's motion for an extension of time in which to prefile its testimony is granted. Citizens shall file its testimony no later than July 19, 2005.
