On May 11, 2005, Kentucky Utilities Company filed an application for approval of the construction of a transmission line in Franklin, Woodford, and Anderson counties, Kentucky. On July 19, 2005, the Concerned Citizens Against the Power Line Extension ("Citizens") filed a motion for an extension of time, until July 22, 2005, in which to file testimony. The hearing in this matter is set jointly with two other transmission line applications for July 26 and 27, 2005.

With regard to the motion for an extension, the Commission understands that problems have occurred with service of data request responses. Moreover, Citizens has had difficulty finding an expert who could testify on its behalf. In light of these problems, the Commission finds that Citizens should have until noon, Eastern Daylight Time, on July 21, 2005, to file its testimony.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Citizens is granted until noon, Eastern Daylight Time, on July 21, 2005, to file its testimony in this case.
