Louisville Gas and Electric contacted the school and requested permission to remove a tree on school property that was infringing on their power lines. The school granted Louisville Gas and Electric permission to remove the tree. LG & E cut the tree down but did not remove the tree from the school's property. We contacted Bill Wheeler at Louisville Gas and Electric who forwarded our call to Jim Matthews. Mr. Matthews informed the school that the school's facilities manager, Curtis Ables, requested they cut down the tree and told them they could leave the tree. The school did not request LG & E cut down the tree, they contacted us, nor did we give them permission to leave the tree on school property. Mr. Matthews reiterated that they were granted permission and when written documentation was requested showing the school granted them permission to cut down the tree and leave it on school property, we were told that there was not any written documentation supporting their claim.

The school contacted an independent contractor for a bid to remove the tree and debris. This contractor told the school that it would cost between \$2,000 and \$3,000 for the tree removal. The school then contacted Louisville Gas and Electric again and notified them of our unwillingness to incur this kind of cost in relation to work that Louisville Gas and Electric performed. During this conversation, Mr. Matthews informed the school that LG & E never removed trees they cut down on private property nor did they have the equipment necessary to remove the tree. He stated that Louisville Gas and Electric would not remove the tree from school property.
