



4. ULH&P's notice sets out no current quarter actual adjustment ("AA"). The total AA of 6.7 cents per Mcf represents no change from the previous total AA.

5. ULH&P's notice sets out no current quarter balancing adjustment ("BA"). The total BA of 5.8 cents per Mcf represents no change from the previous total BA.

6. ULH&P's gas cost recovery rate ("GCR") is \$8.137 per Mcf, which is 25.1 cents per Mcf more than its previous GCR of \$7.886.

7. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for final meter readings by ULH&P on and after June 30, 2005.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter readings on and after June 30, 2005.

2. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, ULH&P shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
