ORDER

The Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of three regional meetings: the Green River Regional Meeting, held October 20, 2005 at the Community Building in Whitesville, Kentucky; the Northeast Regional Meeting, held October 18, 2005 at the Ponderosa Steakhouse in Morehead, Kentucky; and the Western Regional Meeting, held October 27, 2005 at the Ponderosa Steakhouse in Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties." The meetings for which approval is sought include instruction on dealing with emergencies, such as natural disasters, terrorism, vandalism and fire. Having reviewed the KRWA's application describing the courses, the Commission finds that the courses will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be approved for 2.0 credit hours of water district management training per each meeting.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. KRWA's courses of instruction are hereby approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours per meeting.
- 2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course of instruction.
