When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. Where information requested herein has been provided, in the format requested herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request. When applicable, the information requested herein should be provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations, separately.

provided information on how these rates were developed. Provide all workpapers, calculations, assumptions and methodology on how the rates were developed by Grant County.

a. If a cost-of-service study was performed, provide this in digital format in the form of Microsoft® Office Excel 97.

b. If no cost-of-service study was performed, provide all information relative to the development of these rates. Provide all workpapers, calculations, assumptions and methodology on how the rates were developed by Grant County.
