## <u>ORDER</u>

On August 8, 2005, North Shelby Water Company ("North Shelby") requested the Commission to extend for a 10-year period the line enlargement charge established in Case No. 1995-00161.<sup>1</sup>

Due to the expiration of North Shelby's current line enlargement tariff on December 31, 2005 and the Commission's on-going review of North Shelby's request for extension, the Commission entered an Order on December 22, 2005 allowing North Shelby to continue collecting the line enlargement charge as outlined in its current tariff, subject to refund, pending a final decision in this case. Since that time, Commission Staff has requested additional information from North Shelby.

The Commission finds that it is necessary to examine the annual reports filed by North Shelby since the implementation of this line enlargement tariff and that those reports should be made a part of this proceeding.

The Commission further finds that, in Case No. 1995-00161, North Shelby was given a formal hearing to present any testimony relevant to the issue. We believe that the

same opportunity should be extended to North Shelby in this proceeding if requested. Otherwise, this matter can be submitted to the Commission for a decision on the record.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. North Shelby's annual reports filed for the years 1996 through the present are made a part of the record in this case.

2. North Shelby may request a formal hearing before the Commission within 10 days from the date of this Order.

3. If no request for a formal hearing is filed, this matter shall stand submitted to the Commission for a decision upon the record.
