IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motions of Petitioners to intervene are granted.
2. Each Petitioner shall be entitled to the full rights of a party at any hearing and shall be served with the Commission's Orders, but shall not be served with filed testimony,

exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties and shall not be certified as a party for the purpose of receiving service of any petitions for rehearing or petition for judicial review.

3. Should any Petitioner file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, said Petitioner shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
