O R D E R

On February 3, 2006, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) filed a joint motion for leave to amend their joint application for authority to transfer functional control of their respective transmission systems from the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (“MISO”) to the Tennessee Valley Authority (“TVA”) for reliability purposes and to the Southwest Power Pool (“SPP”) for tariff administration purposes. At the time the joint application was filed, LG&E and KU were still negotiating a withdrawal agreement with MISO, a reliability coordinator agreement with TVA, and an independent transmission organization agreement with SPP. Each of those agreements has now been finalized and LG&E and KU propose to amend their joint application to include those agreements in this case. Copies of the agreements are attached to the tendered amended joint application.

Based on the joint motion for leave to amend the joint application to reflect the inclusion of the recently negotiated MISO withdrawal agreement, the TVA reliability

coordinator agreement, and the SPP independent transmission organization agreement, the Commission finds good cause to accept the amended application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the joint motion for leave to amend is granted and the tendered amended joint application is accepted for filing as of this date.
