## <u>ORDER</u>

The Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of three courses of instruction held during the month of January, 2006 at the Lewisport Fire Department in Lewisport, Kentucky; the Ponderosa Steak House in Morehead, Kentucky; and the Ponderosa Steak House in Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties." The conference for which approval is sought includes instruction regarding, <u>inter alia</u>, regulatory and legislative issues, treatment and distribution issues, records keeping, equipment maintenance issues, and effectiveness issues. Having reviewed KRWA's application describing the proposed course, the Commission finds that the proposed course will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or finds that the commissioner and duties and should be approved for 2.0 credit hours for commissioner and board member training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's proposed courses of instruction are hereby approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course of instruction.

3. Within 14 days of completion of the training, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved course of instruction was performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
