<u>ORDER</u>

On May 26, 2006, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") and Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") moved to extend to June 13, 2006 the time to file responses to the Commission's April 25, 2006 Orders and to reschedule the informal conference in these matters to June 20, 2006.

In support of their motions for extension, KU and LG&E noted that the requests for information contained in the April 25, 2006 Orders were extensive and required the collection of information from multiple sources within the companies. KU and LG&E also stated that reviews of the responses by numerous employees were necessary to

ensure the accuracy of the responses. In support of their motions to reschedule the informal conference, KU and LG&E stated that the delay is necessary to allow the Commission adequate time to review their responses.

KU and LG&E served copies of their motions on the Office of the Attorney General and the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. No comments have been received from either party concerning the requested changes in the procedural dates.

The Commission has reviewed the motions and finds the requested changes in the procedural schedule are reasonable. The information that the Orders of April 25, 2006 require involves time periods extending back to 2003. In its May 22, 2006 Order in Case No. 2006-00129, the Commission agreed to KU's request to include additional months in the surcharge reviews. If the companies' motions for extension are granted, there will not be sufficient time for either the Commission or the parties to examine the responses prior to the currently scheduled informal conference. In light of the requested changes in the procedural schedule, the Commission further finds that additional modifications to the existing procedural schedule are required. These modifications, as well as those that KU and LG&E have requested, are reflected in the revised procedural schedule that is shown in Appendix A.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The motions by KU and LG&E are granted.
- 2. The revised procedural schedule set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed.
