O R D E R

On April 26, 2006, Matthew James Hackman filed a formal complaint against Northern Kentucky Water District (“Northern Kentucky”). Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(4)(b), the Commission, on May 4, 2006, directed Northern Kentucky to either satisfy the matters complained of or file an answer within 10 days of service of the Order. On May 15, 2006, Northern Kentucky filed a request for an extension of 20 days within which to attempt to resolve the issue. Northern Kentucky’s filing will be treated as a request for a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(4)(b), to answer or satisfy a complaint within 10 days of service of Commission’s Order and as a motion for an extension of time in which to answer or satisfy the complaint.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, permits the Commission to grant the requested deviation for good cause shown. The Commission finds that Northern Kentucky has shown good cause and should be granted a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(4)(b), and should be allowed an additional 20 days in which to satisfy or answer the complaint.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. Northern Kentucky's request for a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(4)(b), is granted.

2. Northern Kentucky shall have an additional 20 days, up to and including June 5, 2006, to satisfy or answer the complaint.
