<u>ORDER</u>

On March 1, 2006, Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company ("Applicant") filed its Notice of Intent to File an Application for a Certificate to Construct a Nonregulated Electric Transmission Line from the Kenton Substation to the Crescent Substation ("Notice"). However, to date, the Applicant has not yet filed the proposed application, and this matter has lain dormant on the Board's docket for several months.

Pursuant to its inherent authority to administer the application and hearing process under KRS 278.700 - 714, the Board finds that Applicant's Notice should be disregarded and this case should be dismissed if Applicant does not file its application within 20 days of the date of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's Notice shall be disregarded and this case shall be dismissed without prejudice without further Order of the Board unless the Applicant files its application within 20 days of the date of this Order. Done at Frankfort, Kentucky, this 2nd day of March, 2007.
