<u>ORDER</u>

On December 4, 2006, the Commission ordered certain utilities to show cause why they should not be subjected to the civil penalty and their authority to operate in this Commonwealth be revoked for their failure to comply with KRS 278.140 for calendar year 2005.¹ We further ordered that, should a utility fail to respond to this Order within 30 days, its authorization to provide utility service in this Commonwealth would be revoked, its tariff would be cancelled and its name would be removed from the Commission's listing of active utilities.

Of the utilities directed to show cause, only Acorn Telephone, LLC ("Acorn Telephone") and BLC Management, LLC ("BLC Management") have filed the required reports. Arch Wireless Operating Company, Inc. has advised the Commission of its desire to be considered an inactive utility. Although the other entities identified in the

¹ KRS 278.140 requires each utility to file, on or before March 31 of each year, a report of its gross earnings or receipts derived from intrastate business for the preceding calendar year and, if applicable, an annual report. Based upon these reports, the Commission certifies to the Department of Revenue and the Finance and Administration Cabinet the intrastate revenue so collected. KRS 278.150. The Department of Revenue Cabinet then assesses each utility in proportion to its receipts for intrastate business for the preceding calendar year. The proceeds of this assessment are used to finance the Commission's operations. KRS 278.130.

Order of December 4, 2006 were properly served with that Order, they have not submitted a response.

Based upon the foregoing, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The authority of each entity listed in Appendix A to this Order to provide utility service in this Commonwealth is revoked.²

2. The tariff of each entity listed in Appendix A to this Order is cancelled.

3. Any entity listed in Appendix A that wishes to regain authority to provide utility service in the Commonwealth shall pay a penalty of \$250, together with accrued interest at the statutory rate of 12 percent per annum, apply in writing to the Commission for restoration of its authority to provide utility service, and file a new tariff setting forth its rates and conditions of service.

4. Subject to the filing of timely petition for rehearing pursuant to KRS 278.400, these proceedings are closed. The Executive Director shall place any future filings in the appropriate utility's general correspondence file or shall docket the filing as a new proceeding.
