<u>ORDER</u>

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of a course of instruction to be held August 27 through August 29, 2007 in Louisville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The conference for which approval is sought includes instruction on water and wastewater issues, information and security in water and wastewater systems, public relations, budgets and rate structures, and strategic planning. Having reviewed KRWA's application describing the proposed course, the Commission finds that the proposed course will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 12.0 credit hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's proposed course of instruction entitled "Strength in Numbers" is hereby approved for a maximum of 12.0 credit hours.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course

of instruction.

3. Within 14 days of completion of the training, KRWA shall file with the

Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved course of instruction was

performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after

KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
