ORDER

Southeast Daviess County Water District (“Southeast District”) has applied to the Commission for approval of a rate adjustment in accordance with KRS 74.395 for additional financing of an elevated water storage tank, trunk line and appurtenances, and for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct the proposed improvements.

KRS 278.300(2) provides that the Commission shall have 60 days after filing to consider applications for authority to issue or assume securities or evidences of indebtedness unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application. As the Commission has not completed its investigation of this matter, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue the financing application beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the portion of Southeast District's application for authorization to incur additional indebtedness is continued beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).
