On August 27, 2007, Mark Thurston ("Complainant") filed a complaint alleging that Defendant, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E"), overcharged him for utility service to his homes at 8919 Reinhart Way and 2804 Hikes Lane in Louisville, Kentucky. On September 17, 2007, LG&E filed its answer denying the Complainant's claims. On October 10, 2007, Commission Staff served its first data requests to both Complainant and LG&E. Responses to the data requests were due no later than October 26, 2007. LG&E filed its responses to Commission Staff's data requests on October 26, 2007. To date, Complainant has failed to file his responses to the data requests.

The Commission hereby orders Complainant to file responses to Commission Staff's first data requests on or before November 15, 2007. Failure to respond to Commission Staff's request for information on or before November 15, 2007 will result in the dismissal of this complaint. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Complainant shall file responses to Commission Staff's first data requests on or before November 15, 2007.

2. Failure to respond to Commission Staff's request for information on or before November 15, 2007 shall cause dismissal of the complaint.
