ORDER

On August 17, 2007, the city of Russell Springs (“Russell Springs”) notified the Commission of a proposed revision to its wholesale water service rate for East Casey County Water District (“East Casey”) and Adair County Water District (“Adair County”). Russell Springs proposed a rate of \$1.68 per 1,000 gallons to become effective on September 6, 2007, and requested that the 30-day notice period required in KRS 278.180 be reduced to 20 days. Russell Springs also provided letters from both East Casey and Adair County stating that the wholesale customers do not object to the proposed rate.

Having reviewed Russell Springs’ proposed rate and request for a reduction of the required notice period, the Commission finds good cause exists to accept the proposed rate and to reduce, pursuant to KRS 278.180(2), the required notice period to permit the proposed amendment to become effective on September 6, 2007.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The time in which Russell Springs must provide notice to the Commission of the proposed rate is reduced to 20 days.
2. Russell Springs’ proposed rate of \$1.68 per 1,000 gallons is accepted and effective as of September 6, 2007.

3. Russell Springs' proposed tariff is accepted as filed.
