## <u>ORDER</u>

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of regional meetings to be held during the month of October 2007 in Lewisport, Morehead, and Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The courses for which approval is sought include instruction regarding, <u>inter alia</u>, distribution system maintenance, care and maintenance of water storage tanks, inspection of water storage tanks, meter service and setting materials, backflow prevention, and water pipeline repair. Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the proposed courses will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 2.0 credit hours for commissioner training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Each of KRWA's proposed courses of instruction are hereby approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved courses of instruction.

3. Within 14 days of the completion of each conference, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved course of instruction was performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
