ORDER

On December 22, 2005, in Case No. 2005-00042,¹ the Commission approved rates for Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with Duke's Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On December 12, 2007, Duke filed its GCA to be effective January 2, 2008. Duke previously obtained Commission approval to file its GCA within 20 days of the proposed effective date.²

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- Duke's notice includes rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
- 2. Duke's Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") is \$8.841 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.365 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$9.206.

- 3. Duke's notice sets out no current Refund Adjustment ("RA"). Duke's notice sets out a total RA of \$0 per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total RA.
- 4. Duke's notice sets out no current quarter Actual Adjustment ("AA"). Duke's notice sets out a total AA of \$.393 per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total AA.
- 5. Duke's notice sets out no current quarter Balancing Adjustment ("BA"). Duke's notice sets out a total BA of \$.029 per Mcf, which is no change from its previous total BA.
- 6. Duke's Gas Cost Recovery Rate ("GCR") is \$9.263 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.365 per Mcf from its previous GCR of \$9.628.
- 7. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for final meter readings by Duke on and after January 2, 2008.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter readings on and after January 2, 2008.
- 2. Within 20 days from the date of this Order, Duke shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
