On June 26, 2008, Green-Taylor Water District ("Green-Taylor") applied for an adjustment of certain non-recurring charges On July 9 and July 31, 2008, Commission Staff advised Green-Taylor by letter that its application failed to meet certain requirements of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 10, and requested that Green-Taylor cure the deficiencies. Green-Taylor has not responded to these requests.

On August 29, 2008, the Commission ordered Green-Taylor to cure certain deficiencies in its application and stated that "[f]ailure to cure the deficiencies within 10 days shall be cause for dismissal of Green-Taylor's application." As of the date of this Order, Green-Taylor has not cured the deficiencies in its application or otherwise made any attempt to cure these deficiencies.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Green-Taylor's application to revise non-recurring charges is denied.
- 2. This case is closed and is removed from the Commission's docket.
