1. The motion of CAC to intervene is granted.

2. CAC shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.

3. When filing any documents with the Commission related to this proceeding, CAC shall comply with the provisions of the Commission's Order of October 30, 2008.

4. Within 5 days of entry of this Order, CAC shall notify the Commission in writing and all other parties of record electronically of the e-mail address to which all

electronic notices and messages related to this proceeding should be served or, in the alternative, shall notify the Commission and all parties in writing of the reasons why it should not be required to participate in this case through electronic means and of the mailing address to which paper copies of pleadings and documents should be sent.

5. CAC shall file, within 5 days of the date of this Order, a statement as to whether it or its agent is capable of receiving electronic transmissions and whether it waives its right to service of Commission Orders by United States mail.
