ORDER

On October 14, 2008, South Anderson Water District ("South Anderson District") filed with the Commission an application to revise certain nonrecurring charges. In its application, South Anderson District submitted documents that clearly revealed the applicant's tax identification number, bank account numbers, and its office manager's social security number. Federal tax identification numbers and social security numbers are considered confidential and are exempted from disclosure under the Kentucky Open Records Act.¹

Accordingly, the Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. The applicant's bank statements and Merchant Processing Application shall be afforded confidential treatment.
- 2. The Executive Director shall remove from the public records the applicant's bank statements and Merchant Processing Application, and shall substitute a copy in which all federal tax identification numbers, bank account numbers, and social security numbers have been redacted.
