("IGS"), filed on November 6, 2008, for full intervention, it appearing to the Commission that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, and this Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. The motion of IGS to intervene is granted.
2. IGS shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
3. Should IGS file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, it shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.

4. IGS shall, no later than December 10, 2008, file comments setting forth its position on Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc.'s application or, in the alternative, a statement indicating whether it wishes to conduct discovery.
