O R D E R


The Commission, having considered the pleadings of the parties and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that a hearing should be held in this matter to gather additional evidence.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A hearing in this matter shall be held on March 19, 2009, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Blvd., in Frankfort, Kentucky.
2. Pursuant to KRS 278.080 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4, the Commission designates Thomas L. Self as hearing examiner to conduct the hearing in this matter and to perform all actions necessary to ensure the orderly conduct of this hearing, to include administering oaths, receiving evidence, and ruling on motions and objections raised during this hearing.
3. On or before March 16, 2009, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. and Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. shall file with the Commission a list of the witnesses they intend to offer at the hearing and a summary of the issues each witness will present. The witness list shall include the job title and duties of each witness.


