Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of a course of instruction that will be held on February 24 and February 25, 2009 in Bowling Green, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The course for which approval is sought includes instruction regarding, <u>inter alia</u>, water and wastewater assets, asset management, labor issues, record management, emergency response and planning, and asset protection. Having reviewed the KRWA's application describing the proposed course, the Commission finds that the proposed course will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 9.0 instructional hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's proposed course of instruction is accredited for a maximum of 9.0 instructional hours.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course of instruction.

3. Within 14 days of completion of the training, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved course of instruction was performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
