ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of regional meetings held in January 2009 in Dixon, Kentucky; Morehead, Kentucky; and Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The instruction for which approval is sought concerns the laws and regulations governing construction and excavation around underground infrastructure. Having reviewed the KRWA's application describing the instruction, the Commission finds that the instruction will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 2.0 instructional hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. KRWA's proposed course of instruction is accredited for a maximum of 2.0 instructional hours.
- 2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course of instruction.

3. Within 14 days of the completion of the training, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved course of instruction was performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
