ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of training that it proposes to present during May 2009 in Bardstown, Kentucky. The presentations for which approval is sought include instruction regarding e-coli analysis, waterborne pathogens, hydro-excavation, pump and fire hydrant maintenance, smoke testing, Geographic Information System and electronic mapping, sampling procedures, tank inspections, leak detection, and water audits.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the proposed presentations will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 6.0 hours of water district management training.

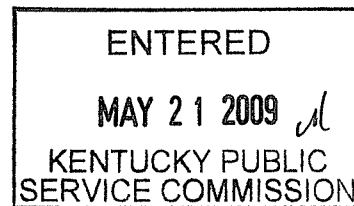
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's 2009 Operator Expo, which is scheduled to be held in Bardstown, Kentucky on May 20-21, 2009, is approved for a maximum of 6.0 credit hours.


2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved course of instruction.

3. Within 14 days of the completion of the training, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved course of instruction was performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
