O R D E R

On May 15, 2009, Defendant, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. (“Columbia”), filed its Answer to the complaint filed by the Complainant, Heather Rae McAtee. In its Answer, Columbia urges the Commission to dismiss the complaint on the grounds that Columbia acted in accordance with all applicable statutes, Commission orders, Commission rules, and Columbia’s tariff. Columbia specifically stated that, according to KRS 278.225, the Complainant is liable for all services supplied by the utility if billed within two years of service.¹

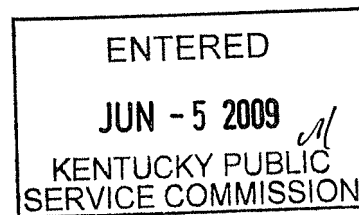
Complainant shall file with the Commission, within 20 days from the date of this Order, a typewritten response to Defendant’s Motion to Dismiss, addressing the issues raised therein. Columbia shall file its Reply, if any, no later than 10 days thereafter.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
