ORDER

On September 30, 1991, in Case No. 1990-00402,¹ the Commission approved certain adjusted rates for Martin Gas, Inc. ("Martin"). In November 2004, Martin proposed, and the Commission approved, changes to its tariff that included, among other items, changes to its Gas Cost Adjustment clause ("GCA"). Those changes updated the methodology of calculating the components of the GCA.

On June 25, 2009, Martin filed a GCA for rates to be effective July 1, 2009. Martin did not give the required 30 days' notice for an increase in rates to take effect on July 1, nor did it request a waiver of the 30 days' notice requirement. After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Martin's notice includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
- 2. Martin's notice sets out an Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") of \$5.0000 per Mcf, which represents no change from its prior EGC.

- 3. Martin's notice sets out no Refund Adjustment ("RA") for the current quarter and no total RA, which is no change from the prior total RA.
- 4. Martin's notice sets out a current quarter Actual Adjustment ("AA") of \$.0031 per Mcf. Martin calculated its AA using an incorrect "EGC in effect for month" for October, November, and December 2008. Staff recalculated the current quarter AA using the EGC of \$5.0064 per Mcf that was actually in effect for these months and dividing the "Total cost difference" by the 12 months of sales of 41,814 Mcf instead of by 214,103.96 as Martin had done. Martin's corrected current AA is \$.0138 per Mcf. Martin's total AA of \$.0103 per Mcf is comprised of the current quarter AA of \$.0138 per Mcf, the previous quarter AA of (\$.0036), and the third previous quarter AA of \$.0001, representing an increase of \$.0138 per Mcf from the previous quarter total AA of (\$.0035).
 - 5. Martin's notice sets out no Balance Adjustment.
- 6. Martin's GCA is \$5.0103 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.0138 per Mcf from its previous rate of \$4.9965 per Mcf.
 - 7. Martin's proposed effective date of July 1, 2009 should be denied.
- 8. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for billing for service rendered by Martin on and after July 25, 2009.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Martin's proposed rates are denied.
- 2. The rates in the Appendix attached hereto and incorporated herein are approved for billing for service rendered on and after July 25, 2009.

3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Martin shall file with the Commission its revised tariff sheets setting out the rates authorized herein.
