O R D E R

On July 15, 2009, Jessamine County Water District No. 1 (“Jessamine District”) filed an application seeking approval of its proposed tariff setting forth a new rate for meter connection and tap-on charges. The new tariff bore an effective date of August 15, 2009. This application was deemed deficient based on the lack of timely notice given the Commission. On August 13, 2009, Jessamine District refiled its application and tariff. The new tariff bears an effective date of September 17, 2009.


Based on a review of the application and the proposed tariff and being sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that an investigation of the new rate is necessary to determine its reasonableness and such investigation cannot be concluded prior to the effective date. Consequently, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the new rate for five months.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jessamine District’s proposed tariff is suspended for a period of five months from September 17, 2009 up to and including February 17, 2010.
