O R D E R

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of its regional meetings in Owensboro, Morehead, and Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The instruction for which approval is sought concerns water line location and leak detection and ground water and surface water contamination. Having reviewed the KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the instruction will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 2.0 instructional hours of water district management training.

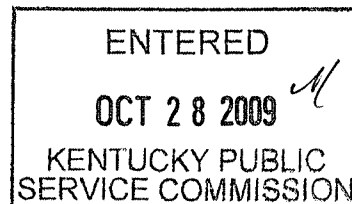
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's proposed courses of instruction at its regional meetings in Morehead, Kentucky on October 13, 2009, Owensboro, Kentucky on October 15, 2009, and Draffenville, Kentucky on October 22, 2009 are accredited for a maximum of 2.0 instructional hours.


2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the approved instruction.

3. Within 14 days of the completion of the training, KRWA shall file with the Commission a sworn statement attesting that the approved instruction was performed and, if any changes in the speakers or course curriculum occurred after KRWA's application, a description of those changes.
