COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND INFORMATION  
REQUEST TO HOPKINSVILLE WATER ENVIRONMENT AUTHORITY

Hopkinsville Water Environment Authority ("HWEA"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and six copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The Information requested herein is due within 14 days from the date of this information request. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

HWEA shall make timely amendment to any prior responses if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which HWEA fails or refuses to

furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations.

1. For each expense listed below, state whether any portion of the expense was allocated to the wholesale customer. If a portion of the expense was allocated to the wholesale customer, explain why the allocation was made. If no allocation was made to the wholesale customer, describe how the expense was removed from the wholesale revenue requirement determination.

a. Transmission and Distribution – Repairs to meters - \$297 (Page E11).


b. Transmission and Distribution – Removing and Re-setting Meters - \$49,457 (Page E 11).

e. Water Administrative and General – Employee Benefits - \$528,203 (Page E12).
