## FIRST DATA REQUEST OF COMMISSION STAFF TO BLACK MOUNTAIN UTILITY DISTRICT

Black Mountain Utility District ("Black Mountain"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and three copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within five days of the date of this Order. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Black Mountain shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Black Mountain fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Black Mountain shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations.

1. The application, page 1, describes the proposed project as consisting of seven miles of distribution line, a booster pump, and a storage tank. In Exhibit A, the Final Engineering Report describes the project as consisting of seven miles of distribution line, three booster pumps, and two storage tanks. The bid tabulations dated August 25, 2009 indicate the project will consist of approximately 9.5 miles of distribution line. Provide an updated description of the project being proposed in this case. If the updated project description differs from that set forth in the Final Engineering Report, provide a revised Final Engineering Report.
