O R D E R

On February 23, 2010, Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation (“Jackson Purchase”) submitted an application to amend certain tariffs. By letter dated March 31, 2010, the Commission rejected Jackson Purchase’s application for failing to meet the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10. On April 15, 2010, Jackson Purchase amended its application and requested permission to deviate from many of the general rate application filing requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10.

In support of its request, Jackson Purchase states that it received authority to revise many of its operating tariffs in connection with its most recent general rate proceeding and that, upon implementation of the new revised tariffs, it encountered unforeseen difficulties and inequities that should be corrected. Jackson Purchase further states that the proposed tariff revisions are not anticipated to increase its revenues and that the information provided in its amended application satisfies the filing requirements that are applicable to the adjustments it seeks in this proceeding.

The Commission, having considered the amended application and the request for permission to deviate, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, hereby finds that:

1. Jackson Purchase has shown good cause for its request and should be permitted to deviate from the remaining filing requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10.

2. The amended application submitted by Jackson Purchase on April 15, 2010 meets all remaining filing requirements and should be considered filed as of that date.

3. Pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates, and such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date of May 15, 2010.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. Jackson Purchase's request for permission to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10, that are not met in the amended application is granted.

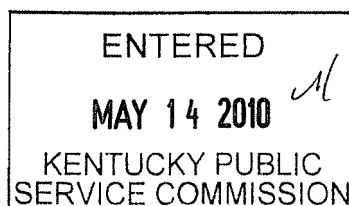
2. Jackson Purchase's amended application shall be considered filed as of April 15, 2010.

3. Jackson Purchase's proposed rates are suspended for five months, from April 15, 2010 up to and including September 14, 2010.
