
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On December 10, 2009, Grant County Sanitary Sewer District ("Grant District") filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and approval for financing. In the application, Grant District requested a waiver of the requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, that the financial exhibits be for a 12-month period, ending not more than 90 days prior to the filing date of the application. In support of its request, Grant District states that the filed Audited Financial Statement for the period ending December 31, 2008 is the most recently published financial data available and that there has been no material change in the financial condition of the utility since that date.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that good cause has been shown by Grant District for its request to deviate from the 90-day requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, and that the motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Grant District is granted permission to deviate from the 90-day requirement of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6.
