O R D E R

On April 30, 2010, Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power”) moved for leave to file rebuttal testimony. It tendered with its Motion the rebuttal testimony of its witnesses, Scott Weaver, Thomas Myers, and Marc Reitter. In support of the Motion, Kentucky Power states that the current procedural schedule does not provide an opportunity for the filing of rebuttal testimony and that its rebuttal testimony is appropriate to address important substantive issues raised in the filed testimony of Lane Kollen, a witness for Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. Lastly, Kentucky Power contends that the rebuttal testimony would aid the Commission in the resolution of this matter and that such filing will not harm or prejudice the other parties.

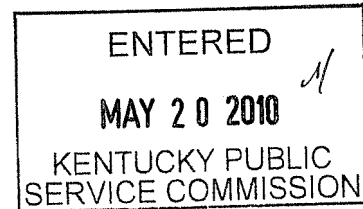
Having reviewed the Motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause to grant the Motion.
