O R D E R

Pending before the Commission is a motion for full intervention filed by the Kentucky Cable Telecommunications Association ("KCTA"). The motion states that KCTA is a non-profit organization consisting of 118 cable television systems serving the majority of cable customers in Kentucky and that KCTA has regularly intervened in rate proceedings on behalf of its member systems. The motion further states that several of KCTA's members attach their facilities to the utility poles of Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), and that they are thus directly affected by KU's pending proposal to adjust its rates for pole attachments.

Based on the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the intervention by KCTA is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. However, KCTA's motion does not identify the specific cable television systems that attach their facilities to the utility poles of KU and that are being represented in this proceeding by KCTA. Therefore, the Commission finds that KCTA should be granted full rights of a party in this proceeding, but, within seven days


of the date of this Order, KCTA should file the names of the cable television systems that it is representing in this proceeding. The Commission also recognizes that a procedural schedule was established in this proceeding by Order dated February 16, 2010. The Commission finds that KCTA should accept the procedural schedule as it now stands.

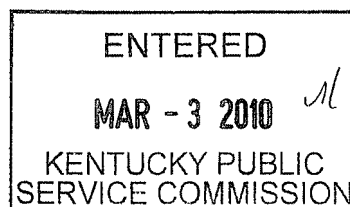
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The motion of KCTA to intervene is granted, and KCTA shall accept the existing procedural schedule.
2. Within seven days of the date of this Order, KCTA shall file the names of the cable television systems that KCTA is representing in this proceeding.
3. KCTA shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, and correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
4. Should KCTA file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of this proceeding, KCTA shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
