O R D E R


On February 12, 2010, Farmers Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Farmers”) filed with the Commission a petition for approval of a revised tariff to recover costs associated with automatic meter reading remote disconnection. The application proposes that the tariff become effective on March 15, 2010. Based upon its initial review of Farmers’ proposed tariff, the Commission finds that additional inquiry is necessary to determine the reasonableness of the tariff and that inquiry cannot be completed by the proposed effective date. Therefore, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed rates for five months.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Farmers’ proposed tariff is suspended for five months from its proposed effective date of March 15, 2010, up to and including August 14, 2010.
