ORDER

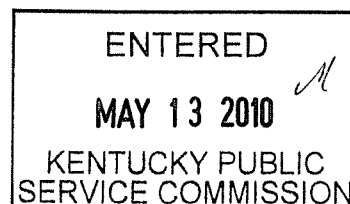
