ORDER

On March 31, 2010, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia") filed with this Commission its Accelerated Main Replacement Program Rider ("AMRP") 2010 annual update data, along with proposed increases to AMRP rates for customer classes subject to the rider. On April 12, 2010, the Commission issued its Order suspending the proposed AMRP rates and established a procedural schedule for the processing of this case. Columbia responded to two rounds of Commission Staff data requests. There are no intervenors in this proceeding. The case now stands submitted for decision.

Having reviewed the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the information contained in Columbia's annual update data, along with its data responses, is in sufficient detail to support the reasonableness of Columbia's proposed AMRP rates.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. The AMRP rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for billing with Columbia's next billing cycle following the date of this Order.
