O R D E R

On May 27, 2010, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") tendered for filing an application for an adjustment of its electric rates based on a forecasted test period. The application proposed that the new rates become effective on July 1, 2010. By letter dated June 2, 2010, the Commission notified EKPC that its rate application was rejected as deficient because it did not include the information necessary to satisfy the filing requirements contained in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(9)(a).

In response to the Commission's rejection letter, EKPC filed, on June 8, 2010, the information cited in the June 2, 2010 letter. The Commission accepted the information and considered the application filed as of June 8, 2010.

Based on the June 8, 2010 filed date and the 30 days' notice requirement set forth in KRS 278.180(1), the earliest possible effective date for EKPC's proposed rates is July 8, 2010. Based on a review of EKPC's application, the Commission finds that an investigation will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that the investigation cannot be completed by July 8, 2010. Therefore, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed rates for six months.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. EKPC's rate application is accepted for filing on June 8, 2010.
2. EKPC's proposed rates, which are to be effective on July 8, 2010, are suspended for six months, up to and including January 7, 2011.
3. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix attached hereto and incorporated herein shall be followed.
4.
 - a. All requests for information and responses thereto shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed and the original and 10 copies shall be filed with the Commission, with copies to all parties of record. Any request for information by letter from the Commission Staff shall be responded to as if set forth in a Commission Order. All responses shall include the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions related to the information provided.
 - b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.
 - c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.

d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

5. Any party filing testimony shall file an original and 10 copies with the Commission, with copies to all parties of record.

6. EKPC shall give notice of the hearing in accordance with the provisions set out in 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5). At the time publication is requested, EKPC shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

7. At any public hearing in this matter, neither opening statements nor summarization of direct testimonies shall be permitted.

8. Any objections or motions relating to discovery or procedural dates shall be filed upon four business days' notice or the filing party shall explain, in writing, why such notice was not possible.

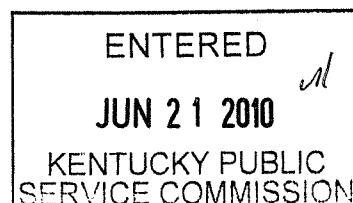
9. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
