O R D E R

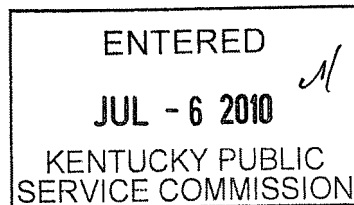
Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of its 2010 Operator Expo held on May 26 and May 27, 2010 in Bardstown, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties." The conferences for which approval is sought include instruction regarding, inter alia, water loss reduction development and implementation, low pressure sewer systems, chemical feed technologies, de-chlorination, establishing a corrosion control program, and emergency dewatering, among other water and wastewater topics scheduled for discussion. Having reviewed KRWA's application describing the proposed course, the Commission finds that the proposed course will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be approved for 6.0 credit hours of water district management training.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's proposed course of instruction is accredited and approved for a maximum of 6.0 hours of water district management training.
2. KRWA shall retain a record of all persons attending the accredited and approved course of instruction.
