On July 2, 2010, Brandenburg Telephone Company ("Brandenburg") filed with the Commission a finalized Extended Area of Service ("EAS") traffic agreement executed by Brandenburg and Comcast Digital Phone ("Comcast"). The parties seek to interconnect their respective networks to allow either party to deliver specific EAS traffic to the other party for transport and termination on the other party's network.

The Commission has reviewed the EAS traffic agreement and finds that it has been appropriately negotiated and conforms to the traffic needs of Brandenburg and Comcast, as provided within the agreement. The Commission finds that implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.


Having reviewed the terms and conditions of the EAS traffic agreement, the Commission finds that the agreement should be approved.
