ORDER

On October 26, 2010, Highland Telephone Cooperative, Inc. ("Highland") moved for an extension of time to file the information requested by Commission Staff in the information request issued on September 27, 2010. Responses to the information request were due on or before October 17, 2010. In its motion for an extension of time, Highland requests an additional 20 days to complete the preparation and filing of the requested information. In support of its motion, Highland states that, due to the small size of the utility's staff, it was unable to collect the requested information and file it within the 20-day time frame set forth in the information request.

Having reviewed the pleading and the arguments contained therein, the Commission finds that the motion for an extension of time should be granted and that Highland should have 20 days from the date of this Order to file responses to the information request issued on September 27, 2010. If Highland fails to submit the responses, the Commission may dismiss this proceeding, without prejudice, by separate Order.

- 1. The motion for an extension of time is granted.
- 2. Highland shall have 20 days from the date of this Order to submit responses to the information request.
- 3. Should Highland fail to submit the responses in accordance with this Order, the Commission may dismiss this proceeding, without prejudice, by separate Order.
